COMING TO BORDEAUX



The airport is located in the town of Mérignac, 10 km from Bordeaux city centre. To get there, you have two choices: a 30' shuttle bus or the liane 1 bus line to the Saint-Jean train station, where you can take the tram.

You arrive by train at the Gare Saint-Jean from where you have to take the Tram to go to the city centre of Bordeaux.





There are many paying car parks in the centre of Bordeaux, but we recommend that you use the Tram's park and ride facilities to get to the city centre.


The three race areas are accessible by tram line A


The sanitary situation in France imposes a set of measures necessary for the event to take place in the best conditions:

- Wearing a mask is mandatory except during your race.
- The distance of one meter between each person is mandatory.
- You are requested to arrive 10 minutes before your start time.
- Do not stay at the finish or at the GEC.
- Hydroalcoholic gel will be available at the reception and at the start.
- Results will only be posted on the Internet.
- Awards will be given out on site.
- Groups of more than 10 people are not allowed on the quays and in the parks.

Thank you for respecting these measures for the safety of all and to show that we are worthy of the trust placed in us by the Prefecture of the Gironde and the Town Halls of Bordeaux and Cenon.

These measures are subject to change.

The races will take place in towns where traffic will not be cut off. All runners must respect the rules of the road before, during and after the races. For the crossing of some busy roads, flag will be present and their instructions must be strictly respected. The time of inter-stations interrupted by traffic will be unmarked.



Race instructions:


- Spikes are forbidden
- The lower parts of the course, at street and tramway level, are strictly forbidden. It is forbidden to run on the pavements or to cross the tram tracks at this level.
- The esplanades are shared with local residents and it is imperative not to disturb them.
- Flagmen will be present on the circuits and will check that these rules are respected.
- Any failure to do so may result in disqualification.

Running instructions:

- Remember to cover your legs. Crampons recommended.
- Some paths may have appeared, or on the contrary may be less marked than on the map.
- The slopes are sometimes steep and can be slippery due to the recent heavy rain.
- The relief is in places very pronounced in the forest areas with cliffs: be careful.
- Vegetation often changes, not all fallen trees are shown.
- The road around the map to the north and west of the map and the adjacent cycle track are forbidden. Do not approach the track as it is below a wall up to several metres high.

- For the crossing of certain roads, there will be flagmen, you must strictly respect their instructions.
- The times of the inter-stations interrupted by the traffic will be cancelled. You have 2 minutes to cross at the green pedestrian light. There may be movements of local residents and the area is crossed by tram lines that run normally.
- In addition to respecting the rules of the road, you must respect the sanitary protocol as well as the private, forbidden and impassable zones on the map.
- Failure to do so may result in disqualification.



Cascade de bois is a new sport that contributes to personal development. In addition to its playful, physical and sensational aspect, it links and forestry, forest construction material.

Woodclimb is in line with the issues of sustainable development and global warming, which threaten the practice of ice climbing for mountain lovers.

It is a sport that brings together the wood industry for the educational lessons and values it conveys.

- In a natural environment where climbing trees designated for harvesting creates a link with the forest, raises awareness of its sustainable management spreads and knowledge of its life cycle. Climbing allows us to honour the tree one last time before it becomes the essential eco-material of our circular economies to store carbon and fight against global warming.
- In the urban environment, it opens the way to a low-carbon approach by creating artificial paths (on building facades or totems) storing a large volume of wood material and spreading knowledge of the virtues of using this biosourced material.
